Husson Lightning was victorious in the first group race for 2 year olds on the Australian racing calendar, the Group Three Maribyrnong Plate, a race previously won by leading sires Bel Espirit, Testa Rossa, Canny Lad, Rancher, Baguette, Vain and Biscay.

Racing only at the highest level, Husson Lightning won or placed in six stakes races. As testament to his early maturity, Husson Lightning's effort to carry 59kgs to victory in Sydney as a December 2 year old was simply outstanding.

Trained by champion trainer David Hayes who commented, "I love it when they carry the big weight and lead and do it all the way. The plan was to sit behind them but he just jumped too well."

Husson Lightning's performances as a 2 year old earned him a timeform handicap rating of 118, confirming him as one of the best 2 year olds of his generation.

Again stakes placed as a 3 year old, Husson Lightning retired to stud in 2008, a sound Group winning sprinter with all the commercial qualities of a future leading sire.

HUSSONET

(Pictured Left). The world's leading active sire son of Mr Prospector at stud. He is responsible for more Group One winners than any other stallion at stud in Australia today. Hussonet took his incredible Group One tally to 28 recently when A Grade sprinter Eagle Falls claimed victory in the 2011 Group One Oakleigh Plate over 1100m at Caulfield. It was the second time in the last four years Hussonet sired the winner of this prestigious Group One sprint. Hussonet is the sire of 75 individual Stakes winners with progeny earnings of over \$37 million worldwide. He has enjoyed remarkable success as an outcross sire to Northern Dancer line mares and is the sire of an Australian Horse of the Year and World Champion Turf Sprinter in Weekend Hussler alongside a long list of distinguished Group One performers including Reanne, a winner of the Group One Blue Diamond, Gold Trail NZ ARC and Railway Stakes Group One.

SNIPPETS

(Pictured Right). Snippets was a Co-Champion Australasian 2 year old and Champion 3 year old sprinter, winning a total of nine races, three at Group One level including the AJC Galaxy - Group One, AJC Sire's Produce S-Group One and VATC Oakleigh Plate - Group One. He is the sire of the winners of \$76 million and 58 Stakes winners including eight at Group One level. As a maternal sire Snippets has continued his Golden Speed influence and to date is the grandsire of the winners of \$44 million and 46 stakes winners. They include some of the most exciting sprinters in Australia today, Snitzel, Unearthly, Magnus, Wanted and the 2010 Golden Slipper hero Crystal Lilly.
